The petitioner has filed the instant criminal writ petition with a prayer that he be released on parole to enable him to perform the last rites of his mother who expired on 17.07.2016.

Notice of motion was issued to the respondents who have informed the Court that on an earlier occasion when the petitioner was granted a benefit of parole, he had committed a murder regarding which he is undergoing the currency of punishment in the instant case.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in

habitual conflict with law, we do not deem it appropriate to grant him the concession of parole but would rather direct the State to take him to his native village while in custody enabling him to perform last rites of his mother on 30.07.2016.

Petition stands disposed of.
