SURYA KANT, J. (ORAL)

1.) Chetan was an Ambulance Driver working in the District Red Cross Society at Faridabad. His services were dispensed with. He challenged that action before the Central Administrative Tribunal presumably on the premise that the Indian Red Cross Society being a Central Government organization, the Tribunal had got the jurisdiction. He unfortunately passed away during pendency of the Original Application. His LRs (the petitioners) were brought on record. The Tribunal has dismissed the Original application for want

of jurisdiction.

2.) In our considered view, the intervening unfortunate incident of the death of predecessor of the petitioners, is such a mitigating circumstance that the Deputy Commissioner, Faridabad is expected to re-consider the whole matter with a view to explore the benefits which can be granted to the petitioners who are the old parents and were fully dependent on the deceased. We have no reason to doubt that the Deputy Commissioner, Faridabad will find out the ways and means to provide full assistance to the petitioners.

3.) The Deputy Commissioner shall also be at liberty to issue necessary instructions to the Civil Surgeon, Faridabad for securing the desired benefits for the petitioners.

4.) A copy of this order be given to Ms. Kirti Singh, learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana for information and for submission of compliance affidavit of the Civil Surgeon, Faridabad.

5.) Disposed of.
