In pursuance of the order dated 15.03.2016, affidavit has been filed.

Counsel for the petitioner admits that the payments have been made, as given in the affidavit. He further submits that the writ had been filed for release of monthly salary etc.

The Executive Officer, who is present in Court, has accepted that in future also, petitioner's salary shall be paid regularly by the 10th day of each month.

In view of the affidavit of the Executive Officer, who has regretted the lapse, the show cause notice issued to him, vide order dated 11.09.2015 is dropped.

With the above undertaking, the present writ petition stands disposed of. However, in case there is any lapse, the show cause notice shall automatically stand revived, on an application being filed.
