On the reduction of the petitioners' salary, they had earlier approached this Court through CWP-5834-2016, **Randhir Singh and another vs. Registrar Cooperative Societies, Haryana and another,** which in view of the remedy available under Section 27 of the Haryana Cooperative Societies Act, 1984 (hereinafter referred to as the 'Act'), was disposed of by giving liberty to the petitioners to avail such remedy.

As per liberty granted, the petitioners approached the Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Haryana, by filing a petition under Section 27 of the Act which through the impugned order has been rejected. Since against the impugned order the petitioners have a statutory remedy of filing an appeal before the Government under Section 114(e) of the Act, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to avail such remedy.

Permitted to do so.

In case, such an appeal the permission for which has been sought and got is filed by the petitioners, the same shall be considered and decided by the Government by passing a speaking order and after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioners, expeditiously but not later than two months from the date of receipt of such appeal.

Needless to add that the decision so taken be communicated to the petitioners and if the decision is not to the satisfaction of the petitioners, they would be at liberty to challenge the same, in accordance with law.
