This order will dispose of two petitions bearing C.W.P. Nos. 1027 and 2975 of 2016.

The prayer of the petitioner(s) is that a direction be issued to the Central Board of Secondary Education (for short 'the Board') for granting approval of admission to the students, who are newly/directly admitted in Class 10 and 12, for which the applications filed by the Schools are pending consideration with the Board. The exams are scheduled from March 01, 2016.

Learned counsel for the Board fairly submitted that the petitioners shall be at liberty to appear at 11 A.M in the Regional Office of Board at Panchkula, on 29.02.2016 for satisfying the requirements for grant of approval for admission to the new/direct students in Class 10 and 12. After hearing representatives of the School, the Board shall pass order assigning the reasons for approval or non-approval of the request made by the petitioners for new/direct admissions in Class 10 and 12.

Considering the fact that the students have been admitted in Class-10 and 12 and the petitioner(s)- school are in communication with the Board ever since the admissions were made as the prayer for approval had to be submitted within one month from the date of admissions and no final decision has been taken by the Board and the examination for Class 10 and 12 are scheduled from March 01, 2016, it is directed that all the newly/directly admitted students in Class 10 and 12 shall be allowed to appear in the exams provisionally subject to the decision taken by the Board and if the decision is against the petitioners and impugned by the petitioners, decision of the Court. The result of the examination shall not be declared without permission of the Court.

The petitions stand disposed of accordingly.
