Prayer made in the instant petition, filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to allow the petitioner to continue his study in the next semester i.e. VIIIth semester and to take the summer course examination of his earlier supplementary examination VIIth semester, which will start from 1st week of June. An alternative prayer has also been made to decide the representation dated 20.04.2016(Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner for the aforesaid relief.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. Amrit Paul, Advocate, who is present in Court today, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and very fairly

submits that representation dated 20.04.2016(Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner will be decided within a week from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant petition.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed as not pressed, however, the respondents are directed to decide the representation dated 20.04.2016(Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner within a week from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
