Instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No. 1-Assistant Collector 1st Grade-cum-Tehsildar, Phillaur to take on record the application dated 26.04.2016 (Annexure P-1) along with documents (Annexure P-2 to P-5)

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that application dated 26.04.2016 (Annexure P-1) along with *jamabandi* for the year 2010-2011 (Annexure P-2), copy of mutation No. 2915 (Annexure P-3) and other documents is required to be placed on record of Assistant Collector 1st Grade-cum- Tehsildar, Phillaur. He further submits that he will supply certified copy of these documents to Assistant Collector 1st Grade-cum- Tehsildar, Phillaur.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

perused the paper-book.

Petitioner will be at liberty to move an appropriate application along with the documents (Annexure P-1 to P-5) before the Assistant Collector 1st Grade-cum- Tehsildar, Phillaur. In case such documents are filed, the same shall be taken on record, however, their evidentiary value will be looked into in accordance with law.
