S.J.VAZIFDAR, ACTING CHIEF JUSTICE (ORAL):

This writ petition is similar to CWP No.3210 of 2015 titled “M/s Nohar Chand Subhash Chand Versus State of Punjab and others”, which is disposed of by a separate order and judgement passed today.

This writ petition is therefore disposed of in the same terms. The impugned orders are quashed and set aside. The petitioner shall be entitled to the allotment of premises in the New Grain Market, Maur Mandi, subject, however, to the petitioner complying with the other terms and conditions and not being found to be ineligible for any other reason. In other words, the petitioner shall not be held to be ineligible merely because there was a gap between

the expiry of the earlier license on 11.01.2005 and the issuance of a fresh license on 17.09.2007. The respondents shall determine the petitioner's eligibility afresh by 31.08.2016, after affording the petitioner an opportunity of being heard.
