JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Four petitioners were students of Elementary Teacher Training (ETT) Diploma for the Session November 2013 to November 2015 in different colleges recognized by the State of Punjab.

It is contended that during the aforesaid period, Government of Punjab sought to fill up 4500 posts of ETT Teachers in the Education Department, Punjab, for which the petitioners have applied for the same. The petitioners were called for counselling by the Director in Recruitment Education, Punjab and vide public notice-cum-merit list (**Annexure P-2**), the petitioners were placed at Merit No. 421, 997, 554 & 1740 respectively. Since the result of the aforesaid two years' diploma course of the petitioners has not been declared despite of final examination conducted by respondent No.3, petitioners by way of present writ petition sought direction for

declaration of their result so as to enable them to compete against the aforesaid advertised posts.

At the time of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that present writ petition has become infructuous as the result of two years' diploma course of the petitioners has since been declared.

In view of the statement made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, present writ petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
