Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the impugned order dated 03.03.2016 (Annexure P-7) passed by respondent No. 2- Financial Commissioner (Revenue), Punjab and order dated 08.11.2010 (Annexure P-5) passed by respondent No. 3-Commissioner, Jalandhar Division, Jalandhar, whereby the mutation sanctioned in the name of the petitioner has been illegally set-aside.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and perused the paper-book.

The issue is with regard to the sanction of mutation. The claim of the petitioners was on the basis of an unregistered Will. The Financial Commissioner (Revenue), Punjab and the Commissioner, Jalandhar Division, Jalandhar have sanctioned the mutation as per the natural succession. I do not find any illegality or perversity in the

impugned orders. The validity of the Will can be agitated before the Civil Court.

Dismissed.
