Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No. 1 to 5 to frame guidelines and fix time frame for implementation of the order dated 01.04.2016 (Annexure P-2).

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and perused the paper-book.

The petitioners are aggrieved against the order dated 17.03.2016 (Annexure P-2) whereby directions have been issued for mandatory fitment of auto-dipper to all types of vehicles (except four wheelers below 50CC) under Rule 106 (1) (C) & (D) of the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989. The only contention raised by learned counsel for the petitioners is that the petitioners are not aggrieved against the order but are only aggrieved against the fact that the same has been made operational immediately.

In view of above, this Court is of the view that no indulgence is called for in the order dated 17.03.2016 (Annexure P-2). However, the State of Haryana is directed to specify some reasonable time, preferably two months for complying with fitment of auto-dipper atleast for those vehicles which are already registered and not having auto-dipper. No action shall be taken by the authorities during the said period.

Petition is disposed of in above terms.
