The petitioner challenges the provisional second counselling of Postgraduate Courses in various specialties and for re-distribution of surrendered seats from All India Quota on same pattern as in the first counselling i.e. 60% to the eligible PCMS in service doctors and 40% to other candidates.

The dispute as such which has been raised by the petitioner is how the other seats from All India Quota are to be re-distributed *inter se* amongst the service candidates and the non-service candidates.

Admittedly, the last date for filling up the vacancies to the Postgraduate Courses is 31.05.2016. The said date has long gone by. At this stage, the petitioner cannot be granted admission to the Postgraduate Course, in view of the directions of the Apex Court, as per the order dated 18.01.2016 passed in I.A. Nos.7 and 8 in Writ Petition (Civil) No.76 of 2015 (Annexure P-6).

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In such circumstances, the issue which is now raked up has become totally academic. The writ petition has been rendered infructuous by sheer efflux of time and is disposed of accordingly.
