Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No. 2-Commissioner, Hisar Division, Hisar to consider and decide application dated 31.07.2015 (Annexure P-13).

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in appeal against the order dated 01.06.2015 (Annexure P-9) before respondent No. 2- Commissioner, Hisar Division, Hisar, stay was granted vide order dated 06.07.2015 till 24.07.2015 but thereafter the same was not extended. The petitioner moved an application dated 31.07.2015 (Annexure P-13) for extension of stay in the appeal.

Be that as it may, the fact remains that the appeal is pending. Application was filed in the appeal, in which stay was granted till particular date. Thereafter, there was no order extending

or vacating the stay and the petitioner moved another application dated 31.07.2015 (Annexure P-13) for extension of stay. The same is not being taken up. The authorities after effecting due service upon the contesting respondents shall finally dispose of the appeal, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. So far as the application for extension of stay is concerned, the same shall be decided on the date fixed, which is stated to be 09.06.2016.

Petition is disposed of in above terms.
