Petitioner seeks the benefit of promotion to the post of Punjabi Mistress from the date her juniors were promoted, i.e., 30.12.2015. It is the case of the petitioner that she was appointed as JBT/ETT Teacher on 10.09.1997 and joined on 13.09.1997. Promotion orders were issued on 30.12.2015 (Annexure P6) which shows the last promoted candidate at Sr.No.280 had joined on 21.12.2001, much after the petitioner. It is the case of the petitioner that she had been approaching the respondents for the benefit of promotion and also served legal notice dated 03.03.2016 (Annexure P8) but of no avail.

Counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, at this stage, if a time-bound decision is taken on the said legal notice.

Notice of motion.

Mr.R.S.Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Copy of the paperbook has been supplied to him.

Keeping in view the limited relief sought, this Court does not feel it necessary to ask the respondents to file reply.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the case and the entitlement of the petitioner and the fact that decision making is still pending, the present writ petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 03.03.2016 (Annexure P8), within a period of 3 months from the receipt of the certified copy of this order. In case an adverse order is to be passed, same be conveyed to the petitioner.
