Petitioner challenge the orders dated 05.01.2012 (Annexure P8) and 07.09.2012 (Annexure P9), whereby her claim for consideration for appointment to the post of Lecturer (Commerce) has been rejected.

It is the case of the petitioner that she had secured 56.723 marks and could not appear for the purpose of counselling and candidates below in merit had been appointed. Resultantly, she had approached this Court, seeking consideration for appointment, which has been rejected vide the impugned orders.

In the written statement filed, it has specifically been averred that the last candidate appointed had merit of 62.763 whereas the petitioner was lower in merit, having marks 56.723 and therefore, she does not fall within the zone of consideration. The allegations that one Pardeep Kaur and Sheetal, who were

below in merit, have also been appointed, has been denied, by averring that their names do not exist in the list of selected candidates.

No replication has been filed to controvert the said averments made in the written statement.

Resultantly, finding no merit in the present writ petition, the same is, hereby, dismissed.
