DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (Oral)

Through order dated 21.01.2015 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Superintendent of Police, Rohtak, for proven acts of omission and commission on his part, the petitioner who was serving the Haryana Police as Exemptee Head Constable has been ordered to be dismissed from service.

Against the afore-referred order of dismissal, the petitioner has filed a statutory appeal dated 20.04.2016 (Annexure P-4) before the Inspector General of Police, Rohtak Range, Rohtak (respondent No.3) which is pending.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, at this stage, he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to take a final decision on the afore-referred statutory appeal dated 20.04.2016(Annexure P-4) preferred by the petitioner within a time bound frame.

I find the prayer made on behalf of learned counsel for the

petitioner to be reasonable.

Accordingly, at this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to take a final decision on the statutory appeal dated 20.04.2016 (Annexure P-4) filed by the petitioner against the order of his dismissal dated 21.01.2015 (Annexure P-3) expeditiously but not later than four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order, by passing a speaking order and after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.
