The petitioner has challenged the order Annexure P.7 by which information required by him has been declined, inter-alia, on the ground that because of the status-quo order passed by the Supreme Court, the said information cannot be supplied.

During the course of the hearing, learned State Counsel has submitted that the order of the Supreme Court has been misunderstood by the Department concerned otherwise the petitioner can be supplied the information as demanded by him subject to payment of requisite fee, in terms of The Land Revenue (Haryana Amendment) Rules, 1996, pertaining to the costs of the revenue record which is to be supplied. According to the respondents, the total cost in terms of the fee is of ₹22,425/-.

The petitioner submits that he has been harassed enough by the respondents and had to incur expenses in engaging the counsel to whom he had paid ₹11,000/- as fees and the said amount may be returned to him as costs.

After hearing the parties and keeping in view the facts and circumstances, this petition is hereby disposed with costs of ₹11,000/- which shall be paid to the petitioner by way of demand draft by the respondents and the respondent No.3, who is present in Court, shall supply the information, as soon as the petitioner deposits the requisite fee.
