The petitioner has assailed the award dated 19.08.2013. The petitioner is stated to have been joined service on 01.08.1997. His services were stated to have been terminated or disengaged w.e.f. 23.08.2000. Before the Labour Court, petitioner-workman did not place any record or material to show that there is a relationship between employer and employee. The same has been taken note of by the Labour Court. It seems that the petitioner had worked through the Contractor therefore, question of appointing him or terminating his services by the employer-Engineering Department do not arise.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner relied on cross examination of MW1-Rajinder Singh who had stated that there was no complaint

received against the petitioner. Giving such statement in cross examination

does not amount to that there is a relationship between the employer and employee in so far as petitioner and the respondent-Engineering Department. That apart, the petitioner has not summoned any record before the Labour Court to substantiate his claim that he was appointed and his services were terminated by the Engineering Department.

3. In view of the facts and circumstances, there is no error apparent on the award passed by the Labour Court dated 19.08.2013.

4. CWP stands dismissed.
