For acts of omission and commission on his part, the petitioner was departmentally proceeded against and having been found guilty, through order dated 28.10.2015 (Annexure P-1) was imposed the punishment of stoppage of one increment with cumulative effect.

Against the afore-referred order of punishment, the petitioner has filed an Appeal before the Government on 02.01.2016 (Annexure P-9). Though this Appeal was filed in January 2016, the same remains undecided till date.

Learned State counsel submits that the afore-referred Appeal filed by the petitioner would be decided by respondent No.1 within a period of three months from the date of a receipt of a certified copy of this order, by passing a speaking order thereupon and after granting opportunity of

hearing to the petitioner.

The above-mentioned statement made on behalf of the learned State counsel, at this stage, satisfies the learned counsel for the petitioner and on such expression of satisfaction, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Needless to add that in case the order of the Appellate Authority is adverse to the interest of the petitioner, he would be at liberty to challenge the same, in accordance with law.
