SURYA KANT, J. (Oral)

(1) The petitioner is a resident of village Burj Gora, Tehsil Dhuri, District Sangrur. He alleges that Sarpanch and Panches of Gram Panchayat of his village, namely, respondents No.6 to 8 are in unauthorized possession of the Gram Panchayat land and there being a conflict of interest, no action is being taken by the Gram Panchayat for removal of such unauthorized encroachments.

(2) The petitioner is said to have made a complaint against the private respondents.

(3) Having regard to the nature of relief sought by the petitioner and without expressing any views on the allegations made by him more-so when we have not heard the Gram Panchayat and private respondents at this stage, we dispose of the writ petition with a direction to the District Development and Panchayat Officer, Sangrur to ascertain the correctness of the petitioner's allegations made in the representation said to have

been submitted on 09.02.2015 (P2) and take necessary action, if need be, in accordance with law, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
