The petition has been filed for directing respondent No. 2 to initiate a comprehensive enquiry regarding prime land allotted to the father of respondents No. 5 and 6, which is stated to have been sold/leased out by them to gain huge profit in complete violation of the letter and spirit of allotment.

On the last date of hearing, i.e. 01.06.2016, learned counsel for the petitioner had taken time to file an affidavit clearly mentioning and depicting his credentials so as to entitle him to file public interest litigation.

CM No.7912-CWP of 2016 has been filed for placing on record affidavit (Annexure P11) of the petitioner as also minutes of an ordinary meeting of the Jullundur Improvement Trust held on 26.02.1969 (Annexure P12) in pursuance of which it was resolved to sell three acres of land to the father of respondents No. 5 and 6 in the Development Scheme of 84.0 acres behind Civil Hospital, which was formerly earmarked for a

private hospital on no profit no loss basis. The affidavit (Annexure P11) and the minutes of the ordinary meeting dated 26.02.1969 (Annexure P12) are taken on record, subject to just exceptions.

During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the petition.

Permitted to withdraw the present petition.
