Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 04.05.2016 (Annexure P-11) and order dated 06.05.2016 (Annexure P-12) passed by the Court Commission of Justice (retd.) Rupinder Singh Sodhi qua the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the paper-book.

The petitioner is aggrieved against the observations made by the Commission with regard to the Federation of Punjab at Sr. No. 26 in order dated 04.05.2016 (Annexure P-11). The petitioner is also aggrieved against the order dated 06.05.2016 (Annexure P-12) passed by the Commission.

This Court is of the view that the Court Commission

was appointed by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi. The petitioner is impugning the findings of the Commission, which have been submitted before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi. If the petitioner is aggrieved against the finding of the Commission, he should approach the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that earlier some other State Association had approached the Hon'ble Delhi High Court and the relief was declined to them and they were relegated to file their petition before local authorities.

In view of above, the present petition is dismissed for want of jurisdiction. This Court cannot otherwise go into the order passed by the Hon'ble Delhi High Court. The petitioner will be at liberty to approach the Hon'ble Delhi High Court for redressal of its grievances.
