Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No. 2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the employees of the petitioner-company by providing adequate police protection as petitioner is apprehending threat from respondents No. 5 to 7.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has already issued a legal notice dated 28.04.2016 (Annexure P-1) to respondents No. 2 to 4 but no decision has been taken as yet.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of, without issuing notice to the respondents, with a direction to respondent No.2- The Commissioner

of Police, Ludhiana, to look into the issue raised in the legal notice dated 28.04.2016 (Annexure P-1) and take appropriate decision on thereon, in accordance with law, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order so that right of the petitioner to conduct his lawful business is not interfered with. Copy of the order so passed shall be communicated forthwith to the petitioner.
