RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (ORAL)

On 23.09.2016, I passed the following ad interim order:

“Having read the letter dated 12.8.2016 sent by the learned District & Sessions Judge, Rewari, on the reimbursement case of the petitioner, the parties are sent to the Mediation & Conciliation Centre annexed to this Court to thrash out the dispute. Both the parties to assist the Mediator to resolve the lis. This is necessary because the learned District & Sessions Judge has in the letter said that they need details of the package charges amounting to ₹4,00,000/- incurred for the treatment of the ailment of the District Court employee not in consolidated sum but in details of the amount spent on treatment etc. The Mediator would read the letter and take such steps in mediation as he deems fit. Parties to appear before the Mediation & Conciliation Centre annexed to this Court on 4.10.2016. Parties to produce documents before the Mediator. The learned District & Sessions Judge, Rewari, in the meantime may prepare the list of things for the petitioner to do to claim reimbursement and intimate the same to the petitioner either before or on the date of mediation,

preferably before, but not longer than on the date of mediation to enable the petitioner to present his documents accordingly, other if not already submitted.

List again on 6.12.2016.”

Today, the Court is informed that the matter has been settled in the Mediation & Conciliation Centre annexed to this Court, which renders the instant petition infructuous since the claim stands satisfied.

Dismissed as infructuous.
