JASWANT SINGH, J.(ORAL)

The case of the petitioner for appointment, against 3 posts of Lecturer in Economics under the Backward Class category based on the selections pursuant to the 40 posts advertised on 22.09.2009, has been declined vide speaking order dated 11.10.2013 on the ground that waiting lists of the said advertisement stood scrapped on 13.08.2013. The grievance raised is that a similarly placed candidate-Venus Juneja has been subsequently, vide order dated 13.03.2014, appointed as Vocational Mistress (Taxation Practice) inspite of the selection/waiting list having stood scrapped.

On being asked, learned State Counsel on instructions from Mr.

Shashi Kumar, Law Officer, DPI (Secondary Education), Punjab submits

that in case of Venus Juneja the appointment order has been issued pursuant to the decision dated 25.10.2013 rendered by this Court in CWP No.20148 of 2012 titled as Venus Juneja Vs. State of Punjab & Ors. as upheld in Latter Patent Appeal No.403 of 2014 titled as State of Punjab & Ors. Vs. Venus Juneja and, therefore, no sustenance can be drawn by the petitioner in view of the appointment of Venus Juneja.

Faced with this situation, learned Counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
