Learned counsel for the petitioner admitted that an amount of ₹80,940/- has been paid to the petitioner. However, now the petitioner is claiming gratuity as per revised pay scale and the interest on delayed payments.

So far as the interest on the delayed payment is concerned, the respondents are liable to interest. Hence, the respondents are directed to release the payment of interest on the retiral benefits of the petitioner @ 9% per annum starting three months from the date of retirement till the actual payment within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

So far as the grant of gratuity on the revised pay scale is concerned, the respondents are directed to check-up whether any additional payment falls due with regard to gratuity on the revised pay of the petitioner. If it is found that any payment with regard to gratuity on the revised pay scale

falls due to the petitioner, the same shall also be paid to the petitioner within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In view of the above the present petition is disposed of.
