In the instant writ petition, the petitioner has prayed for quashing order dated 24.04.2007 (Annexure P2) and 22.06.2015 (Annexure P7).

The petitioner is stated to have been appointed as a Constable /General Duty and he has joined service on 18.01.2006. The respondents found that the petitioner was suffering from Red Green Colour Deficiency. Therefore, they are of the view that he is unfit for further retention in service. After due consideration of his representation on 24.04.2007, his services have been terminated on account of medically unfit.

Admittedly, the petitioner has not questioned the order of termination dated 24.04.2007 till filing of this petition in the month of May, 2016. The petitioner has slept over the matter from 2007 to 2016.

There is a delay and laches on the part of the petitioner. On this ground, the petition is rejected.
