Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh-respondent No.2 to decide the matter before him at an early date and preferably on the date already fixed.

Till the matter is decided by the Financial Commissioner, Status quo regarding possession shall be maintained by the parties.

With the above observations, present writ petition is disposed of.
