Eight petitioners were students of Elementary Teacher Training Diploma (ETT) for the Session November 2013 to November 2015 in different Colleges recognized by State of Punjab.

Government of Punjab in November 2015/April 2016 sought to fill up 4500 posts of ETT Teachers in the Education Department,Punjab extending the last date for submission of the applications form by 9.4.2016.

Since the examination of the aforesaid two years diploma course in various

present writ petition sought direction for declaration of result of the Diploma Course so as to enable them to compete against the aforesaid advertised posts. Hence the present writ petition.

At the time of hearing learned counsel for the petitioners submits that present writ petition has become infructuous as the result of their two years diploma course has since been declared.

In view of the statement made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, present writ petition is dismissed as infructuous as also various applications filed by applicants for their impleadment and also for vacation of stay require no further orders and are accordingly disposed of as infructuous.
