Matter relates to overstay in the Government accommodation by the petitioner. The petitioner's husband was allotted Government accommodation on 28.4.2009 under the Separated Family Accommodation Scheme (for short 'SFA Scheme'). Initial allotment was for three years and it was extended in the year 2012. Thereafter on 25.4.2014 it was extended for about a month i.e. till 31.5.2014. The petitioner is continuing to stay beyond 31.5.2014 by virtue of interim order of this Court. The petitioner has not made out a case for interference with the impugned action of the respondents. However, the petitioner be permitted to occupy the allotted accommodation under the SFA Scheme till 31.3.2017.

With the above observation, petition stands disposed of.
