The petitioner approached this court with a grievance that his result for B.A. Part-I English (Communication Skills) was not declared, as the answer sheet was misplaced.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner would be satisfied in case he is granted minimum pass marks.

Learned counsel for the respondents submitted that there was some fault of the official of the University on account of which the answer sheet was misplaced. The University is ready and willing to grant minimum pass marks in that subject. The revised marks sheet shall be issued to the petitioner within a period of two weeks from today.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of in view of the stand taken by learned counsel for the
