M. JEYAPPAUL, J.(ORAL)

As report has been submitted by the Mediation Centre in the light of the directions issued by this Court.

In terms of the settlement arrived at between petitioner and second respondent an amount of ₹ 5,00,000/-(Rupees Five lacs only) in the shape of bank draft was handed over to the petitioner. The petitioner has agreed to convert the same into FDR. The second respondent having agreed to pay a sum of ₹ 3,000/-per month to the petitioner towards her personal expenses has undertaken to bear the entire family expenses. The petitioner and the second respondent have agreed to vacate the premises of respondent No. 1 on or before 27.06.2016.

Learned counsel appearing on either side submits that the Civil Writ Petition may be disposed of in terms of the compromise arrived at between by the parties. Accordingly, the writ petition stands disposed of.
