The grievance of the petitioner is that licences of Arms Dealership granted to the petitioner, which expired on 31.8.2015, have not been renewed despite submission of application and completion of paper formalities.

For the purpose, the petitioner has even made a representation dated 14.7.2015 to the Secretary, Government of Punjab, Department of Home Affairs and Justice, but even despite that, he has not received any response.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, however, without opinion on the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to take a final decision on the representation submitted by the petitioner for renewal of Arms Dealership Licences. The needful be done within a period of two months

from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. In case, it is found that the petitioner is not entitled to renewal of licences, a reasoned order shall be passed and communicated to the petitioner in the aforesaid period.
