Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent nos. 1 and 3 has informed the Court that the University has sought the option from the petitioner for the pension scheme and the matter is pending before the Government for giving the final sanction.

Mr. Tribhuvan Dahiya, Advocate for respondent nos. 1 and 3 is not disputing this fact as petitioner has already given their option.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of by giving liberty to the petitioner to take appropriate steps after the government has taken final decision on the pension scheme which is pending consideration for sanction.

In case the government accord sanction to the pension scheme, the respondent-University will take appropriate steps within 3 months.
