The petitioner had earlier filed CWP No.9493 of 2016 in which following order was passed on 16.5.2016:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, prays for withdrawal of this petition in order to file it again with better particulars giving details of crop sown by the petitioner which is alleged to have been destroyed because of white fly and the petitioner has been given less compensation by the Government of Punjab in terms of its scheme.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

Liberty granted.”

The petitioner has though filed the present petition but he has not given the details of the crop sown which is alleged to have been destroyed. The petitioner has in fact refiled the petition without providing

the necessary inputs for the purpose of holding an inquiry in the matter.

Consequently, I do not find any reason to interfere in this petition.

Dismissed.
