The petitioner seeks grant of equivalent pay scale as given to Classical and Vernacular Teachers on the strength of the judgment passed by this Court in '*Gokal Deep Mehta and others Vs. State of Punjab and others*' 1992 (5) SLR 269.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has filed a representation dated 21.08.2015 (Annexure P-4) with the respondent No.2 for the necessary relief, which is still pending consideration and almost a year has gone by. It is submitted that he would be satisfied if the same is decided within a time bound frame. It is further submitted that benefits have been granted to others who have approached this Court but the same has not been done in the case of the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. R.S. Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Copies of the writ petition have been supplied to him in the Court.

Keeping in view the limited relief sought, this Court is of the opinion that there is no need for the respondents to file reply.

Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of the case, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the representation dated 21.08.2015 (Annexure P-4) within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case the financial benefits are found to be due, the same be paid within a period of 2 months thereafter. Needless to say if the relief is to be denied, a reasoned order be passed and conveyed to the petitioner.
