The petitioner has approached this court for issuance of a direction to the respondents to release the payment of the work executed by its members.

There being no document on record to show that liability is admitted by the respondents, in a writ jurisdiction no roving enquiry can be made, firstly to find out whether the amount is due or not and then take up the issue regarding payment thereof.

Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed. However, the same will not debar the petitioner from availing of its appropriate remedy in accordance with law.
