The petitioners' grievance is with the developer, who sold them plots in the year, 2012, but have not provided many of the basic amenities such as sewerage, water supply etc. Even roads have not been constructed properly. Electricity supply is defective. The grievance is addressed to the official respondents also.

The official respondents concerned shall take a decision regarding the petitioner's complaint after giving the petitioner and private respondents an opportunity of hearing. If the petitioner's grievance seems to be justified, the official respondents shall take necessary action against the private respondent as may be necessary on the petitioner's representation/complaint by 31.08.2016.

In the meantime, the official respondents shall also pass interim orders and directions to the private respondent, if found it necessary.

The writ petition is disposed of accordingly.
