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**JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)**

Petitioner-Kuljit Singh has laid challenge to the order dated 04.01.2016 (**Annexure P-5**), whereby his claim for appointment on compassionate ground for the post of Constable has been declined by the Inspector General of Police, Head Quarters (respondent No. 3 herein).

It is the case of the petitioner that his real uncle-S. Gurvail Singh was killed by the terrorists on 27.03.1990, and pursuant to his claim for compassionate appointment, he had passed the physical tests, however, has been wrongly declared medically unfit for enlistment as Constable due to amputation of left thumb.

At the time of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to show any instructions whereby the real nephew i.e. relative would be entitled to seek compassionate appointment being a relative of terrorists' affected person. The petitioner cannot claim himself to be a dependant of

the deceased-person, that apart, claim, even otherwise, would be barred by delay and laches.

In view of above, no case for interference is made out, accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
