HARI PAL VERMA J.(Oral)

Petitioner M/s Malwa Tourist Private Ltd., Moga has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India for issuing appropriate direction to respondent No.2 to frame joint time table on Zira to Moga via Kot Ise Khan-Jhatre and back route.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the buses of the Punjab Roadways have been granted permit from Zira to Moga via Jhatre, but they are operating this route via Kot Ise Khan. He submits that he approached to respondent No.2 for redressal of his grievance by making

representation dated 17.3.2016 (Annexure P-8) and he would be satisfied if direction be issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide his claim as projected in the representation.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Ranbir Singh Pathania, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of copies of paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting on the claim as projected by the petitioner in his representation (Annexure P-8), the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the said representation (Annexure P-8) by giving an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
