Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus restraining the respondent Nos.1 to 3 from interfering in the peaceful possession of the petitioners over the land situated at village Badshahpur, District Gurgaon, owned and possessed by them and also directing the respondent No.4 to take action upon the complaint dated April 6, 2016 (Annexure P-8).

I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

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The more efficacious remedy of filing of civil suit is available with the petitioners. So far as the complaint is concerned, if the petitioners feel it appropriate they can avail the other remedy including filing of criminal complaint, in which they will have opportunity to lead evidence.

Dismissed.
