1. Reply filed. The same is taken on record.
2. The writ petition has been filed seeking a direction to the official respondents to conduct an enquiry through CBI or any other independent agency and take legal action as respondents No.2 to 9 have committed embezzlement of the funds of the Punjab Police Welfare Co-operative Multipurpose Society Ltd., Bathinda. In the alternative, the writ petitioners have prayed for a writ of mandamus directing respondent No.1 to decide the representation (Annexure P-5) dated 5.5.2015, submitted by the petitioners as well as others members of the Society to respondent No.1.
3. Respondent No.6 has filed reply. Counsel for respondents No.1, 2 and 6 submit that they have no objection for allowing the alternative

prayer sought for by the writ petitioners.

4. In view of the above, a direction is issued to respondent No.1 to decide the representation (Annexure P-5) dated 5.5.2015 filed by the petitioners and dispose of the same within 2 months from the date of this order.

5. With the above direction, the writ petition stands disposed of.
