Application for withdrawal of the writ petition has been filed on the ground that the petitioner has been reinstated in service. Counsel submits that the dismissal was on account of the conviction recorded by the Trial Court and the petitioner's order of conviction was stayed by the Sessions Judge, Kapurthala on 20.04.2015. The dismissal order dated 21.04.2015 (Annexure P8) was passed inspite of the said stay granted. But, now, counsel for the petitioner submits that as the petitioner has been reinstated in service, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the same be disposed of as such.
