Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to file a petition afresh.

It was noticed that the appellate authorities' order has attained finality. If the petitioner has not challenged the appellate authorities' order before any other Forum, to that extent liberty cannot be granted.

With above observation, petitioner is permitted to withdraw the present petition. If petitioner demonstrate that he had questioned the validity of the appellate authorities order, modifying the penalty from compulsory retirement to reduction of pay before any other authority. He is at liberty to file petition in so far as modification of penalty also.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
