The present petition has been filed for quashing of show cause notice dated 13.05.2016 (Annexure P9) for cancellation of allotment of Dwelling units No. 1106 Sector 39-B, Chandigarh issued by Executive Engineer (Enforcement) Chandigarh Housing Board, Chandigarh - (Respondent no.3).

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the show cause notice was issued on 13.05.2016 and the reply was to be filed upto 25.05.2016. Learned counsel further submits that there is an apprehension that the action can be taken at any point of time.

Notice of motion to respondents.

Mr. H.S.Dhindsa, Advocate, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of Union Territory, Chandigarh and on instructions from Mr. Sunil Malik, XEN Enforcement, Chandigarh Housing Board submits that the petitioners will be given an opportunity of hearing and

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action will be taken after considering the reply to show cause notice.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for Union Territory, Chandigarh the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case any reply is required to be filed by the petitioners or any representation is to be given to respondent no.3 within one week of getting copy of the order, the same be considered and necessary action be taken within a period of one week thereafter after passing a speaking order.

However, in case the petitioners are still aggrieved by any action of the respondents, they are at liberty to challenge the same in accordance with law.
