RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, fairly states that since in compliance of the order dated 24.9.2016 passed by this Court, appropriate order has been passed by respondent No.2, present writ petition has been rendered infructuous, so far as registration of Transfer Deed was concerned. However, he submits that petitioner may be permitted to approach the respondent-Municipal Committee, by moving an appropriate representation, seeking issuance of No Dues Certificate and respondent-Municipal Committee may be directed to consider the grievance at an early date by passing an appropriate order thereon.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, the present writ petition is disposed of, with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondent-Municipal Committee, by moving an appropriate representation within a period of three weeks from today and Executive Officer of respondent-Municipal Committee is directed to consider the grievance to be raised by the petitioner in her representation and decide the same at an early date by passing an appropriate order thereon, however, in any case within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of representation from the petitioner.

With the above-said observations made and directions issued, the instant writ petition stands disposed of.
