The grievance of the petitioner is that respondent No.5- Union of Truck Operators is not permitting the petitioner to transact its business of transportation rather insisting that trucks of the Union be hired from their agency only, that too, on higher charges. Petitioner has not been permitted to carry the goods even in its own fleet of vehicles.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no person can be coerced to conduct his business with such a surrender before unreasonable demands of respondent No.5 which is neither legitimate nor have any sanctity in law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that notification issued by the government also prevents such a coercive action of respondent No.5.

This petition can be disposed of without issuing any notice to the respondents at this stage with a direction to respondent No.2 to have a fair look on the controversy raised by the

petitioner in this writ petition and take appropriate action in accordance with law and ensure that no untowards and unreasonable activity take place in the controversy as projected by the petitioner.
