Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the observations made by the 4th respondent-Education Tribunal in the impugned order passed by it on 2.6.2016 (Annexure P-8) may adversely affect the process of disciplinary proceedings initiated as against the 1st respondent. If the observations made by the 4th respondent are neutralized, the petitioner is ready to withdraw the present writ petition.

In view thereof, permission is granted as sought for and the writ petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.

It is made clear that the observations made by the 4th respondent while passing the impugned order will not have any bearing on the disciplinary proceedings conducted by the writ petitioner against the 1st respondent.
