MAHESH GROVER, J.

The only prayer made in the instant petition is that a mandamus be issued directing the official respondents to take action against respondent no.6 and the BDPO for misusing their powers.

Learned counsel for respondents no. 5 and 6 has stated that inquiry was conducted and no truth was found in the allegations made by the petitioner. An affidavit of Gurdial Singh (Panch) – respondent no.6 has also been filed in this regard in Court today and the same is taken on record.

In view of the aforesaid affidavit, no cause survives in the instant petition as the only mandamus that the petitioner sought need not be granted as the respondents have looked into the allegations. Hence, instant petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous, leaving the petitioner to other remedies in law.
