1. The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to issue allotment letter to the petitioner in his name as Plinth Site/House No.775/Bhaskar Colony, Sector 25, UT, Chandigarh had been allotted to him.
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the concerned respondent by way of filing a representation.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn.
4. However, it is observed that in case such a representation is filed by the petitioner, the same shall be decided by the concerned authority expeditiously after hearing the petitioner and by passing a speaking order.
